



Artist Project Planning Template

The Artist Project must:

Exist beyond a traditional classroom format

- Engage with space
- Include interaction (with audience or environment)

It does NOT require:

- A public exhibition space
- A large budget
- A crowd of people

Core Question

Before any idea:

***“How does my work interact with a space or a viewer?”
If you can answer this clearly, they are already on the right track.***

Possible Spaces (due to constraints)

Domestic Spaces:

- Living room
- Bedroom
- Balcony
- Kitchen
- Bathroom (yes, interesting for themes of identity, routine, vulnerability)

Semi-Public Spaces:

- Building hallway
- Rooftop
- Garage
- Staircase

Outdoor / Limited Access:

- Street view from the window
- Front door/entrance
- Small garden
- Sidewalk

The Audience

Your audience can be:

- Family members
- Roommates
- Neighbors (observing from distance)
- People passing by (no direct contact needed)
- Online viewers (video/photo interaction)
- The artist themselves (self-interaction counts if intentional)

If you currently can't have access to people:

You can:

- Use yourself as the audience
- Record interaction
- Simulate audience participation
- Use online viewers

What matters is:

Intentional interaction, not the number of participants.

Types of Interactions

Interaction does not mean “touching.” It can be:

Physical

- Moving through space
- Rearranging elements
- Walking around the work

Visual

- Changing perspective
- Discovering hidden elements
- Light/shadow interaction

Participatory

- Writing, drawing, responding
- Leaving something behind
- Making choices

Digital

- QR codes
- Filmed reactions
- Instructions shared online

Documentation

Students must document:

- The space
- The setup process
- The interaction
- Audience response (if possible)

Formats:

- Photos
- Video

- Screenshots
- Short written reflections

Attention:

The video component is a mandatory requirement from IB. You must record and document short clips of your entire process, using either a digital camera or your cellphone.
